



All fires are to be contained within BBQ's and fire rings only. Fireworks are prohibited. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas. Fire prevention must be the first concern of every visitor.

Pets must be restrained by a six-foot leash at all times.

Possession or use of firearms or weapons is prohibited.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.

Park users must remain on the trails and in designated use areas at all times.

Wood gathering is prohibited.

Minors (under 18 years) should be accompanied by an adult at all times. Exception: Youth Group Camp - designated sponsor acceptable.

Trails are subject to closure for at least 3 days after rainfall.

Camping reservations must be placed by adults with identification. Maximum 15 day camping stay per month.

Camping quiet time is 10:00p.m. Checkout time is 2:00p.m.



This park depends on you to protect all wildlife, vegetation and geologic features. These are protected and are not to be damaged or removed from the park premises.

This is a wilderness area characterized by certain inherent dangers. These dangers may include mountain lions, rattlesnakes, poison oak, poisonous insects, extremes in weather and rugged terrain. Your safety cannot be guaranteed. Stay alert to potential danger.
